Nursery Fees and Charges

If your child is eligible for funding from 9 months onwards they can access the sessions between the hours of 8am and 5:30pm Monday to Friday, to a total of their allocated hours at no additional cost. Funding can be used just during school term time (38 weeks per year) or it can be spread over 51 weeks (less hours each week). Do speak to us about this.

Funded only sessions must be booked in 4 hour blocks commencing at either 8:00, 8:30, 9:00 or 9:30 am for morning sessions and from 12:00, 12:30, 1:00 or 1:30 for afternoon sessions. We will happily discuss this further with you, to help you work out the most effective use of your funding as we know this can be confusing!

About our Fees

All prices include a morning and afternoon snack. A cooked lunch and dessert can be added for £2.50 per day on any day(s) of your choice or you can provide your child with a healthy packed lunch.

Breakfast can be added for 75p per day for bookings commencing before 8:30am and a light tea can be added for £1.75 per day for bookings ending after 4.30pm.

For funded sessions we do not charge for consumables, or top up fees of any kind.

We are open 51 weeks per year, closing for one week at Christmas and for all bank holidays throughout the year. We do not charge for these closures.

We cannot refund for absence due to illness, holiday or any other reason.

Extra/Ad-Hoc Bookings

Additional ad-hoc sessions may be available, by prior arrangement. These are invoiced at the end of each month.
